The Buena Vista Vinicultural Society, formed in 1863 by the winery's founder, Count Agoston Haraszthy, to further improve its winemaking prowess and expand its vineyards, has been restored as a collection of unique, small-production wines that honor the winery's pioneering spirit and contribution to California winemaking. The Vinicultural Society explores clonal selections, varietals and the incredible terroir of California's Sonoma County.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Named for Count Haraszthy's son who managed Buena Vista Winery with his father, Attila's Selection Zinfandel was sourced from vineyards in the warmer region of Sonoma Valley as well as in the Russian River where the days are warm and the nights are cool, the perfect growing conditions for Zinfandel – a varietal The Count helped make prominent in America. This big, bold wine was fermented in open top fermenters with hand punch downs before being aged for 16 months in French oak, 37% new oak.

TASTING NOTES

Shimmering in a luminous garnet-red hue, this exceptional Zinfandel enchants with enticing aromas of ripe black cherry, delicate floral hints, and a subtle touch of cracked pepper. The palate unfolds with the richness of juicy red plum and luscious blackberry, effortlessly enhanced by a spark of citrus zest and a whisper of smoldering tobacco. Silky tannins, elegantly interlaced with layers of aromatic spices, create a harmonious medley of flavors, all uplifted by a vibrant, exhilarating acidity, leading to a gracefully crisp and captivating finish.
