The Buena Vista Vinicultural Society, formed in 1863 by the winery's founder, Count Agoston Haraszthy to further improve its winemaking prowess and expand its vineyards, has been restored as a collection of unique small-production wines that honor the winery's pioneering spirit and contribution to California winemaking.

The Vinicultural Society explores clonal selections, varietals and the incredible terroir of Sonoma County. In keeping with the adventurous spirit of Buena Vista's founding, we are proud to bring you this delicious Karoly's Selection Petite Sirah.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Named for Count Haraszthy's father, who devoted much of his life to his passion for wine—from tending vineyards to sharing his wines—Karoly's Selection Petite Sirah honors this distinctive varietal with roots in Southern France. Often used as a blending grape, Petite Sirah is known for its deep color, bold tannins, and concentrated dark fruit character.

TASTING NOTES

Glowing with a deep crimson hue, this wine entices the senses with opulent layers of dark fruit, gracefully highlighted by the richness of ripe plum. The palate reveals a dynamic interplay of flavors—succulent black cherry, ripe blackberry, velvety chocolate, and a delicate hint of warm spice. Bold and expressive, this full-bodied wine is framed by polished tannins that impart both balance and refinement, carrying through to a resonant, enduring finish that lingers with distinction and allure.
