The Buena Vista Vinicultural Society, formed in 1863 by the winery's founder, Count Agoston Haraszthy to further improve its winemaking prowess and expand its vineyards, has been restored as a collection of unique small-production wines that honor the winery's pioneering spirit and contribution to California winemaking. The Vinicultural Society explores clonal selections, varietals and the incredible terroir of Northern California.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Named for Count Haraszthy's youngest daughter, Otelia's Selection Pinot Noir is sourced from the elevated slopes of Sonoma Mountain, where cool daytime temperatures and steady airflow preserve freshness and finesse. Harvested on October 21, 2023, the grapes were aged for 14 months in 19% new French oak, before being bottled on December 18, 2024.

TASTING NOTES

This Pinot Noir brims with floral-laced fruit and aromatic lift. Vibrant notes of blueberry and thyme bring clarity and freshness, while layers of wild strawberry, forest floor, and cola spice unfold across a medium-bodied, velvety palate. A lively streak of acidity provides energy and drive, leading to a long, savory finish accented by hints of leather and subtle smoke.
