The Buena Vista Vinicultural Society, formed in 1863 by the winery's founder, Count Agoston Haraszthy to further improve its winemaking prowess and expand its vineyards, has been restored as a collection of unique small-production wines that honor the winery's pioneering spirit and contribution to California winemaking. The Vinicultural Society explores clonal selections, varietals and the incredible terroir of Northern California.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Named for the Count's eldest son, who fought in the Civil War, Geza's Selection Pinot Noir reflects the North Coast's diverse landscape and ideal growing conditions. Cooling marine fog and afternoon breezes help preserve freshness and acidity while extending the growing season, allowing the fruit to develop complexity and balance. Vineyards span a range of elevations and well-draining volcanic, alluvial, and loamy soils, contributing depth, structure, and layered character to the finished wine.

TASTING NOTES

This Pinot Noir reflects the region's cool coastal influence and diverse vineyard sources, offering expressive aromatics and layered complexity. Notes of ripe cherry, wild strawberry, and raspberry are complemented by hints of rose petal, baking spice, and forest floor. The palate is silky and vibrant, with refined tannins, bright acidity, and subtle nuances of black tea and toasted oak leading to a balanced, lingering finish. The North Coast's mix of coastal freshness and warm inland ripening helps create Pinot Noir with both elegance and depth.
