#### VINICULTURAL SOCIETY

The Buena Vista Vinicultural Society, formed in 1863 by the winery's founder, Count Agoston Haraszthy to further improve its winemaking prowess and expand its vineyards, has been restored as a collection of unique small-production wines that honor the winery's pioneering spirit and contribution to California winemaking. The Vinicultural Society explores clonal selections, varietals and the incredible terroir of Northern California.

#### WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Harvested on September 29th, the grapes were sourced from the Ricioli vineyard, west of Fulton, in the Russian River Valley. The grapes were whole-cluster pressed with native fermentation and the lees were stirred occasionally to lend creaminess to the mid palate.

#### TASTING NOTES

Radiant aromas rise from the glass, blending tangerine, lime zest, and peach with the delicate sweetness of honeysuckle. Light and graceful on the palate, this white wine reveals lively acidity and vibrant tartness. Crisp green apple, grapefruit, and lemon shine in harmony, while subtle notes of ripe melon and blanched almonds add depth and refinement. The journey concludes with a refreshing, clean finish that lingers beautifully, leaving a bright and memorable impression.
