#### VINICULTURAL SOCIETY

The Buena Vista Vinicultural Society, formed in 1863 by the winery's founder, Count Agoston Haraszthy to further improve its winemaking prowess and expand its vineyards, has been restored as a collection of unique small-production wines that honor the winery's pioneering spirit and contribution to California winemaking. The Vinicultural Society explores clonal selections, varietals and the incredible terroir of Northern California.

#### WINEMAKER'S NOTES

The Count identified the Sonoma County climate and soil as the optimal location for growing quality Pinot Gris. We honor his vision with our 2025 Count's Selection Pinot Gris. The grapes for this wine were harvested in the very early morning of September 15.

#### TASTING NOTES

This lively wine opens with a vibrant bouquet of bright citrus, white peach, and delicate floral notes. Medium-bodied, it offers a smooth, rounded texture layered with flavors of ripe pear, golden apple, and hints of tropical fruit, complemented by a touch of honeyed richness and a subtle spice nuance. The finish is crisp, refreshing, and gracefully lingering.
