HERITAGE SPARKLING BRUT NORTH COAST

While Agoston Haraszthy was most recognized as being the Father of California viticulture, he was also the father of six illustrious children. His third son, Arpad, spent over two years in France learning the craft of sparkling wine and later became the first to introduce Méthode Traditionelle sparkling wine into California winemaking.

Arpad's sparkling wine, Eclipse, was one of the most celebrated in the nineteenth century; we pay tribute to his legacy through this Brut sparkling wine of Pinot Noir and Zinfandel grapes.

With grapes harvested from the beautiful North Coast region, this sparkling wine highlights the delicate balance and harmony between the noble Pinot Noir and elegant Zinfandel grapes.

TASTING NOTES

Bright and expressive, this North Coast Brut reveals inviting aromas of green apple, Meyer lemon, and white peach layered with hints of brioche and fresh almond. Crisp orchard fruit and citrus flavors carry through the palate, complemented by delicate notes of pear blossom and a touch of minerality. Fine, persistent bubbles and vibrant acidity create a beautifully balanced texture, leading to a clean, refreshing finish with elegant lift.
